

TOD TIDS

for planting the best Hanging Baskets and Containers



- 1 Choose a suitable basket or container from our selection.
- 2 For a wire basket you will also need a basket liner.
- Always use a good quality compost and add Stay Wet water absorbent crystals to the compost before filling your basket.
- 4 Choose your plants from our seasonal greenhouses and plant area.
- When planting a wire basket, plant from inside-out pulling the foliage through the sides of the basket.
- When you have finished making your basket or container always water in well making sure that all the plants soak up the water.
- 7 Baskets and containers do need regular watering. Do check even if it has been raining if the baskets are against a wall, they can be very sheltered.
- After four weeks, feed every ten days through the growing season with Tomorite or Hanging Basket Liquid Feed.
- Dead head taking off all old stems and flowers once a week, this encourages new flowers to follow.



For a 14" wire hanging basket we would recommend 6 plants for the sides and 3 upright plants for the top together with a mix of a further 6 filling or trailing plants to go around the edges.
